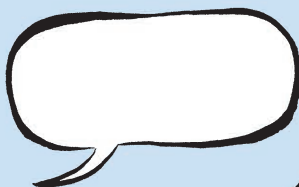
Gutter:

talking.



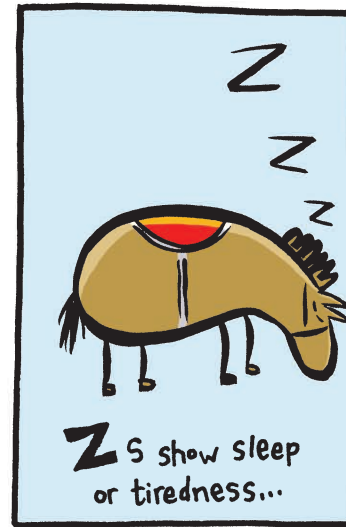
Thought Balloon:

depending on what's being said:

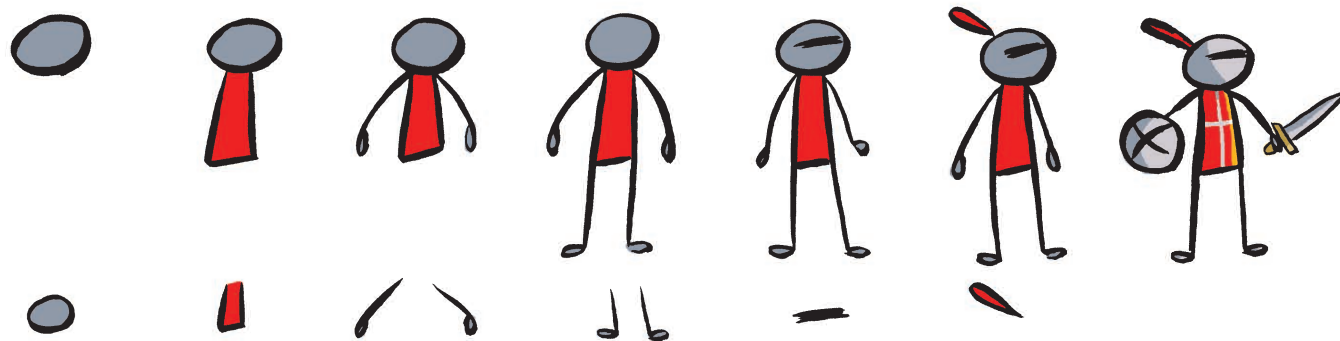
